Second Graders Help Shriners Help Children

This year's Second Grade Service Project was to help hospitalized children by collect aluminum can tabs for donation to the Shriners Hospital for Children. On Tuesday, June 2, Alvriss Collins and Greg Murphy, representing the Sudan Shriners, accepted 55 pounds of can tabs from the second grade classes.

"On behalf of all the children this will help, I sincerely thank you," said Collins. Collins initiated the can tab drive several years ago. The tabs, which are pure aluminum, are sold to recyclers with the money raised being used for items that go directly to children in the Shriners Hospitals. Collins told the children that the money raised goes for things like,

"Games and puzzles for the children, amputee socks, stuffed animals... anything that can give the children in the hospital some comfort while they are there," Murphy told the students, "I am so very proud of what you've done for the Shriners Hospital and the children who go there." Murphy is the Maintenance Supervisor at Arapahoe Charter School.

The Shriners Hospitals are a network of hospitals that treat children with neuromusculoskeletal conditions, burn injuries and other special healthcare needs regardless of the child's race, color, creed, sex or sect, disability, national origin or ability of a patient or family to pay.
